

MEDICAL EXAMINATION FAQs – PART 10

HEARING STATION

Q-1: What is the Hearing station?

A-1: At the Hearing station you will be placed in a sound proof booth and asked to identify different frequencies of sound transmitted through earphones.

Q-2: What are some test results that may require further evaluation?

A-2: Further evaluation will be required if the test results show that hearing loss in the unaided better ear is greater than 40 decibels (dB) at 500 Hz, 1000 Hz, 2000 Hz, and 3000 Hz.
